37	Section 1. Section 79-6-1001 is enacted to read:
38	79-6-1001. Definitions.
89	As used in this part:
0	(1) "Lab" means the State Energy Lab established in Section 79-6-1002.
1	(2) "Center" means the San Rafael Energy Research Center established in Section
-2	<u>79-6-1003.</u>
3	(3) "Director" means the director appointed under Section 79-6-1004 to oversee the
4	center.
5	(4) "Project proposal" means a formal written submission to the lab applying for
6	approval and funding of a specific research initiative conducted at the center.
7	Section 2. Section 79-6-1002 is enacted to read:
8	79-6-1002. State Energy Lab.
9	(1) There is established in the office the State Energy Lab that is composed of the
0	following nine members:
1	(a) the executive director of the office, or the director's designee, who shall serve as
2	chair of the board;
3	(b) the president of the University of Utah or the president's designee;
4	(c) the president of Utah State University or the president's designee;
5	(d) the commissioner of higher education, as described in Section 53B-1-408, or the
6	commissioner's designee;
7	(e) two members appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;
8	(f) two members appointed by the president of the Senate; and

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59	(g) one member appointed by the governor.
60	(2) The lab shall:
61	(a) foster innovation and support technological development in the energy sector by
62	collaborating with industry leaders, researchers, entrepreneurs, investors, and other
63	stakeholders;
64	(b) identify areas of economic growth and workforce development opportunities
65	related to emerging energy technologies and solutions;
66	(c) seek potential investors and partners from the technology, finance, and business
67	sectors to support innovative research and early-stage ventures focused on developing
68	commercializable energy technologies in the state;
69	(d) identify and prioritize high-impact research projects for the center aligned to the
70	state's energy policy goals and focused on developing commercially viable technologies; and
71	(e) develop evaluation criteria for project proposals received under Section 79-6-1004
72	including:
73	(i) alignment with state energy policy priorities;
74	(ii) commercialization potential;
75	(iii) economic impact; and
76	(iv) other relevant factors as determined by the board;
77	(f) recommend allocation of center resources and funding for project proposals;
78	(g) enter into financial contracts with entities seeking to use the center; and
79	(h) consult with relevant stakeholders for input on energy research priorities and
80	potential collaborations.
81	Section 3. Section 79-6-1003 is enacted to read:
82	79-6-1003. San Rafael Energy Research Center established Center director.
83	(1) There is established in the lab the San Rafael Energy Research Center to facilitate
84	innovative energy research and development projects.
85	(2) The purpose of the center is to:
86	(a) conduct innovative energy technology research and development projects that have
87	significant commercialization potential and support the state's energy policy goals;
88	(b) assess the viability of emerging energy solutions for deployment within the state,
89	considering:

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90	(i) cost-effectiveness;
91	(ii) dispatchability;
92	(iii) sustainability;
93	(iv) reliability; and
94	(v) environmental impact;
95	(c) provide analysis and recommendations to policymakers regarding energy system
96	planning, infrastructure needs, and the value of different energy initiatives being considered
97	within the state; and
98	(d) collaborate with universities, industry partners, entrepreneurs, community
99	representatives, and other research entities.
100	(3) The State Energy Lab shall appoint a full-time director to oversee the day-to-day
101	operations of the center.
102	Section 4. Section 79-6-1004 is enacted to read:
103	79-6-1004. Project proposal solicitation and approval process.
104	(1) The lab shall have an open project proposal solicitation process to facilitate
105	innovative energy research and development aligned with state energy policy conducted at the
106	center.
107	(2) The lab shall receive and accept project proposals from:
108	(a) academics and research faculty from universities and research institutions in the
109	state;
110	(b) private sector companies operating in the state, including technology entrepreneurs
111	and small businesses;
112	(c) government agencies and national laboratories;
113	(d) nonprofit organizations and foundations engaged in energy research; and
114	(e) other qualified research teams.
115	(3) The lab shall evaluate project proposals received under Subsection (2) through a
116	competitive process in order to select proposals for approval and funding.
117	(4) The lab may make rules, in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah
118	Administrative Rulemaking Act, establishing detailed project proposal evaluation criteria and
119	selection procedures.
120	Section 5. FY 2025 Appropriation.

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121	The following sums of money are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1,	
122	2024, and ending June 30, 2025. These are additions to amounts previously appropriated for	
123	fiscal year 2025.
