WHEREAS, illegal immigration is costing Utah taxpayers over \$931,000,000 per year,

27	WHEREAS, an estimated 137,000 illegal aliens live in Utah;
28	WHEREAS, an unchecked flow of illegal aliens into the state will impose an even

30	WHEREAS, drugs flow through the southern United States border at an unprecedented
31	rate, and crime and rape run rampant at the southern United States border;
