22 23	<i>Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:</i>
24	WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the value and importance in educating students
25	about the principles and benefits of free enterprise and entrepreneurial thinking; and
26	WHEREAS, integrating and fostering free enterprise and entrepreneurship education at
27	all levels of the education system will instill students with valuable skills to identify business

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28 opportunities, cultivate an entrepreneurial mindset, develop self-reliance, and empower 29 students to become critical thinkers and to take calculated risks to effectively navigate the 30 business landscape in a rapidly evolving economy: 31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah 32 encourages schools and educational institutions to incorporate free enterprise and 33 entrepreneurship education into existing curricula or offer specialized courses that teach 34 fundamental principles of free enterprise, entrepreneurship, business management, financial 35 literacy, and innovation. 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature supports the development and dissemination of free enterprise and entrepreneurship education resources, including teacher 37 38 training programs, professional development, curriculum materials, and experiential learning 39 opportunities. 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature urges educators to foster a free 41 enterprise and entrepreneurial mindset among students, emphasizing attributes such as critical thinking, problem-solving, adaptability, perseverance, and effective communication. 42 43 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature encourages the incorporation of 44 hands-on activities, competitions, project-based learning, and real-world simulations that 45 expose students to practical entrepreneurship experiences and challenges. 46 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature supports collaboration among all 47 levels of educational institutions and partnerships with local entrepreneurs, business leaders, 48 and community organizations to provide students with guidance, inspiration, and real-world 49 connections.
