

26           (1) As used in this section, "public cold bath" means a tub or tank that:  
27           (a) is used by:  
28           (i) the general public, regardless of whether there is a charge or payment for use; and  
29           (ii) one bather at a time; ~~§~~→ [and] ←~~§~~  
30           (b) contains chilled water that is:  
31           (i) maintained at a temperature lower than 60 degrees Fahrenheit;  
32           (ii) no more than 180 gallons in volume; and  
33           (iii) at a depth that allows the bather to maintain the bather's head above the water  
34 while in a seated position ~~§~~→ [;] ; and  
34a           (c) continuously filters and sanitizes the chilled water. ←~~§~~  
35           (2) The department may not adopt a rule that restricts, limits, or imposes requirements  
36 on the operation of a public cold bath.  
37           Section 2. **Effective date.**  
38           This bill takes effect on May 1, 2024.
