9 The Retirement and Independent Entities Interim Committee recommended this bill.

10 Legislative Vote: 10 voting for 0 voting against 5 absent

11 **General Description:**

12 This bill addresses the sunset provision for the Heber Valley Historic Railroad  
13 Authority.

14 **Highlighted Provisions:**

15 This bill:

16 ▶ extends the sunset date for the Heber Valley Historic Railroad Authority for five  
17 years.

75 "(1) "Commission" means the Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice."; and

76 (d) Subsection [63M-7-305\(2\)](#) is repealed and replaced with:

77 "(2) The commission shall:

78 (a) provide ongoing oversight of the implementation, functions, and evaluation of the  
79 Drug-Related Offenses Reform Act; and

80 (b) coordinate the implementation of Section [77-18-104](#) and related provisions in  
81 Subsections [77-18-103\(2\)\(c\)](#) and (d).".

82 (22) The Crime Victim Reparations and Assistance Board, created in Section  
83 [63M-7-504](#), is repealed July 1, 2027.

84 (23) Title 63M, Chapter 7, Part 8, Sex Offense Management Board, is repealed July1,  
85 2026.

86 (24) Title 63M, Chapter 11, Utah Commission on Aging, is repealed July 1, 2026.

87 (25) Title 63N, Chapter 1b, Part 4, Women in the Economy Subcommittee, is repealed  
88 January 1, 2025.

89 (26) Title 63N, Chapter 2, Part 2, Enterprise Zone Act, is repealed July 1, 2028.

90 (27) Section 63N-2-512, related to the Hotel Impact Mitigation Fund, is repealed July  
91 1, 2028.

92 (28) Title 63N, Chapter 3, Part 9, Strategic Innovation Grant Pilot Program, is repealed  
93 July 1, 2027.

94 (29) Title 63N, Chapter 3, Part 11, Manufacturing Modernization Grant Program, is  
95 repealed July 1, 2025.

96 (30) In relation to the Rural Employment Expansion Program, on July 1, 2028:

101 (31) In relation to the Board of Tourism Development, on July 1, 2025:

102 (a) Subsection 63N-2-511(1)(b), which defines "tourism board," is repealed;

103 (b) Subsections 63N-2-511(3)(a) and (5), the language that states "tourism board" is  
104 repealed and replaced with "Utah Office of Tourism";

105 (c) Subsection 63N-7-101(1), which defines "board," is repealed;

106 (d) Subsection 63N-7-102(3)(c), which requires the Utah Office of Tourism to receive  
107 approval from the Board of Tourism Development, is repealed; and

108 (e) Title 63N, Chapter 7, Part 2, Board of Tourism Development, is repealed.

109 (32) Subsection 63N-8-103(3)(c), which allows the Governor's Office of Economic  
110 Opportunity to issue an amount of tax credit certificates only for rural productions, is repealed  
111 on July 1, 2024.

112 Section 2. **Effective date.**

113 This bill takes effect on May 1, 2024.
