Section 1. Section 36-11-302 is amended to read:
36-11-302. Improper influence Communication with an elected official's
employer prohibited.
A person may not seek to influence the vote of any legislator through communication



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28	with the legislator's employer.]
29	(1) As used in this section:
30	(a) "Elected official" means:
31	(i) a member of the Legislature;
32	(ii) a member of the legislative body of a local government;
33	(iii) a member of a board of education; or
34	(iv) the mayor of a city, town, or metro township.
35	(b) "Elected official" includes a person who is appointed to fill a vacancy in the office
36	of an elected official described in Subsection (1)(a).
37	(2) A person may not seek to influence the vote of an elected official through
38	communication with the elected official's employer.
39	Section 2. Effective date.
