#### **General Description:**

This bill requires a local education agency (LEA) to use semesters or quarter for the LEA's school schedule.

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**53G-7-224**, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53G-7-224** is enacted to read:

#### 53G-7-224. School schedules.

- (1) As used in this section:
- (a) "Alternative high school" means a public education program established by an LEA that:
- (i) is designed to meet the needs of a student ages 14 through 18 who is at risk of not graduating from a traditional high school for reasons including:
  - (A) academic credit deficiency;
  - (B) history of suspension, expulsion, or other disciplinary issues;
  - (C) pregnancy, parenthood, or a need to work during regular school hours;
  - (D) physical or mental health conditions; or
  - (E) homelessness or unstable home environment; and
- (ii) features an environment tailored toward an at-risk student population through elements including:
  - (A) flexible school schedules;
  - (B) online or blended course options in addition to in-person instruction;
  - (C) life skills components; and
  - (D) college and career readiness support.
  - $(\frac{1}{2}b)$  "LEA" means the same as that term is defined in Section 53E-1-102.
- (\{b\}c) "School schedule" means the planned allocation of instructional time for courses throughout a school year.
- (2) Beginning in the 2025-2026 school year and except as provided in Subsection (3), an LEA shall adopt a school schedule consisting only of semesters or quarters.
- (3) An LEA may adopt a school schedule other than the type of school schedule described in Subsection (2) if:
  - (a) the LEA is a charter school;
- (b) the LEA is a school district and all schools within the school district have the same school schedule; or

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(c) the school within the LEA is an alternative high school.

Section 2. Effective date.

This bill takes effect on May 1, 2024.
