The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 52**, INDUSTRIAL HEMP AMENDMENTS, by Representative J. Dailey-Provost, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 8 through 11:
 - 8 { Committee Note:
 - 9 The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee
 - 10 recommended this bill.
 - 11 <u>Legislative Vote: 14 voting for 0 voting against 5 absent</u> }
- 2. Page 7, Lines 197 through 200:
 - 197 (3) { The } Beginning January 1, 2025, the department shall provide to the State Tax Commission:
 - 198 (a) a regularly updated list of every retailer permittee that sells a cannabinoid product;
 - 199 (b) any information obtained by the department regarding a person who is not a retailer
 - 200 permittee and is selling a cannabinoid product; and
- 3. Page 69, Lines 2120 through 2122:
 - 2120 (3) { Money } Subject to appropriation, money in the account may be used for the following:
 - 2121 (a) enforcement of Title 4, Chapter 41, Hemp and Cannabinoid Act by the Department
 - 2122 of Agriculture and Food;

- 4. Page 74, Lines 2269 through 2277:
 - 2269 (1) Except as provided in Subsection (2), this bill takes effect on January 1, 2025.
 - 2270 (2) { The the actions affecting the following sections take effect on May 1, 2024 } If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, the actions affecting the following sections take effect upon approval by the governor, or the day following the constitutional time limit of Utah Constitution, Article VII, Section 8, without the governor's signature, or in the case of a veto, the date of veto override :
