## NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

February 27, 2024

Mr. Speaker,

The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee deleted **H.B. 65**, ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION AND CANAL TRAIL AMENDMENTS, by Representative R. T. Lesser, and replaced it with **1st Sub. H.B. 65**, ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION AND CANAL TRAIL AMENDMENTS, with the following amendments, and has returned it to the Rules Committee.

- 1. Page 3, Lines 68 through 72:
  - 68 (ii) mail a copy of the notice of intent to abandon the prescriptive easement to:
  - 69 (A) each [municipal and] county government, municipal government, and, if
  - 70 <u>applicable</u>, <u>each special district</u>, <u>special service district</u>, <u>and</u> <u>metropolitan</u> <u>planning organization</u> where the easement or part of the easement is
  - 71 located [<del>.</del>]; and
  - 72 (B) the Department of Transportation.
- 2. Page 4, Lines 93 through 97:
  - 93 <u>72-1-218.</u> Canal trails.
  - 94 (1) As used in this section, "political subdivision" means a municipality, city, town,
  - 95 <u>county</u>, {<u>or</u>} <u>metro township</u> {<u>as defined in Section 10-2a-403</u>} <u>, special</u> <u>district, or special service district</u> <u>.</u>
  - 96 (2) The department, in coordination with the Department of Agriculture and Food and
  - 97 the Department of Natural Resources, shall:
