Mr. Speaker,

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 111**, EMPLOYMENT TRAINING REQUIREMENT LIMITATIONS, by Representative T. Jimenez, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 8, Line 220 through 224:
 - (h) (i) It is unlawful to subject an individual, as a condition of employment,
 - 221 {<u>membership, certification, licensing, credentialing, or passing an examination, to training,</u>
 - 222 <u>instruction, or any other required activity that espouses, promotes, advances, or compels the</u>
 - 223 <u>individual to believe or</u>} <u>to</u> <u>profess a belief in any of the following concepts and constitutes</u>
 - 224 <u>discrimination based on race, color, sex, or national origin:</u>
- 2. Page 8, Line 237 through 243:
 - 237 (F) that an individual, by virtue of the individual's race, color, sex, or national origin,
 - should be subject to discrimination or adverse treatment to achieve diversity, equity, or
 - 239 inclusion; or
 - 240 (G) that virtues including merit, excellence, hard work, fairness, neutrality, objectivity,
 - 241 <u>and racial colorblindness are racist or sexist, or</u> { the creation of } that members of a particular race,
 - 242 <u>color, sex, or national origin</u> <u>created these virtues</u> <u>to oppress members of another race, color, sex, or national origin.</u>
