The Judiciary Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 146**, HUMAN TRAFFICKING AMENDMENTS, by Representative S. Gricius, with the following amendments:

Page, Line 28 through Page 2, Line 41: 28 (2) The state human trafficking intervention coordinator shall: 29 (a) provide support and resources to state and local prosecutors on human trafficking 30 prosecutions throughout the state; 31 (b) coordinate support for victims of human trafficking throughout the state; 32 {\_(c) assist in the creation of the human trafficking and exploitation educational program established in Section 53B-16-112; **33** 34 <del>\_(d)\_</del>} promote awareness among the general public about human trafficking, victim 35 remedies and services, and trafficking prevention; 36 (d) promote training on human trafficking prevention and victim services {<del>\_(e)</del>} for state and 37 local employees who have recurring contact with victims or perpetrators of human trafficking; 38 (e) present annually at professional development conferences throughout the state directed toward primary and secondary school teachers, administrators, and support staff 39 40 regarding human trafficking awareness and prevention; and 41 {<del>\_(g)</del>} <u>(f)</u> <u>conduct other appropriate activities related to human trafficking.</u>
