The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 289**, PROPERTY RIGHTS OMBUDSMAN AMENDMENTS, by Representative K.
Birkeland, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 11 through 16:
 - 11 This bill:
 - 12 {-clarifies | provides | that a party who prevails in court on an issue that the Office of the Property
 - Rights Ombudsman previously decided in the party's favor { is } may be entitled to an award of
 - 14 attorney fees;
 - provides that the party described above may be entitled to collect a civil penalty and
 - 16 consequential damages in certain circumstances; and
- 2. Page 3, Lines 70 through 74:
 - 70 (12) Subject to Subsection (13), if the Office of the Property Rights Ombudsman issues
 - an advisory opinion described in this section, and if the same issue that is the subject of the
 - 72 <u>advisory opinion is subsequently litigated in court on a cause of action alleging the same</u> facts
 - and circumstances that are at issue in the advisory opinion, and if the court resolves the
