Mr. Speaker,

The Transportation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 292**, SNOWPLOW AMENDMENTS, by Representative A. Cory Maloy, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 11 through 14:
 - 11 This bill:

 - 13 ► clarifies that { an authorized emergency vehicle } <u>a government</u> <u>snow plow</u> may not be cited for a lighting
 - 14 violation.
- 2. Page 2, Lines 33 through 40:
 - 33 (3) "Authorized emergency vehicle" includes:
 - 34 (a) <u>a</u> fire department [vehicles] vehicle;
 - 35 (b) <u>a police [vehicles] vehicle;</u>
 - 36 (c) [ambulances] an ambulance; and
 - 37 {<u>(d) a snow plow, when operated at the direction of the state or a political</u> subdivision of

38 <u>the state;</u> and

- 39 (d) { (e) } other publicly or privately owned vehicles as designated by the commissioner
- 40 of the Department of Public Safety.
- 3. Page 14, Lines 424 through 426:
 - 424 (b) The provisions of Subsection (1)(a) do not apply to head lamps, spot lamps,
 - 425 auxiliary lamps, flashing turn signals, hazard warning lamps, [and] school bus warning
