The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 296**, READING DISABILITY AMENDMENTS, by Representative S. Pulsipher, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 33:
 - 33 (c) "Dyslexia" means a { specific learning disability } learning disorder

 that:
- 2. *Page 2, Lines 52 through 54:*
 - 52 (4) (a) If a benchmark assessment or supplemental reading assessment indicates a
 - student lacks competency in a reading skill, <u>is demonstrating characteristics of</u>

 <u>dyslexia</u>, or is lagging behind other students in the student's
 - 54 grade in acquiring a reading skill, the school district or charter school shall:
- 3. Page 3, Line 76:
 - assessment for students in kindergarten through grade 3.
 - (6) A student with dyslexia is only eligible for special education services if the student meets federal eligibility criteria.
