NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

February 27, 2024

Mr. Speaker,

The Public Utilities, Energy, and Technology Committee deleted **H.B. 307**, FIREARM DATA AMENDMENTS, by Representative S. Hayes, and replaced it with **1st Sub. H.B. 307**, FIREARM DATA AMENDMENTS, with the following amendments, and has returned it to the Rules Committee.

- 1. Page 2, Lines 33 through 42:
 - 33 (1) As used in this section:
 - 34 (a) "Commission" means the State Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice.
 - 35 (b) "Law enforcement agency" does not include {
 - 36 <u>(i) a law enforcement agency established under Title 23A, Wildlife Resources Act; or</u>
 - 37 ______ the Department of Corrections, including Adult Probation and Parole.
 - 38 (2) (a) {Beginning } Except as provided in Subsection (2)(c), beginning on July 1, 2026, a law enforcement agency shall annually, on or
 - 39 <u>before April 30, submit a report to the commission for the previous calendar year containing:</u>
 - 40 (i) the number of crimes reported to or investigated by the law enforcement agency in
 - 41 which the law enforcement agency determined that a lost or stolen firearm was used in the
 - 42 commission of the crime, separated by the type of crime; and
- 2. Page 2, Lines 51 through 54:
 - 51 (b) A law enforcement agency shall compile the report described in Subsection (2)(a)
 - 52 for each calendar year in the standardized format developed by the commission under
 - 53 <u>Subsection (3).</u> <u>(c) The reporting requirements under Subsection (2)(a)(i) do not apply to a crime or</u> <u>investigation for an offense under Title 23A, Wildlife Resources Act, that involves a firearm.</u>
 - 54 (3) The commission shall:
