Mr. Speaker,

The Business and Labor Committee recommends **H.B. 321**, EVICTION RECORDS AMENDMENTS, by Representative M. Judkins, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 321**, EVICTION RECORDS AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 26 through 33:
 - 26 (1) [(a)] Without the filing of a petition, a court shall order expungement of all records
 - 27 of an eviction if:
 - 28 [(i)] (a) (i) the entire case was dismissed;
 - 29 (ii) there is no appeal pending for the case; and
 - 30 (iii) at least [three years] { 90 } 120 days have passed from the day on which the eviction was
 - 31 [filed] dismissed; or
 - 32 (b) the parties to the eviction stipulated to expungement and have filed a stipulation
 - with the court.
