Mr. Speaker,

The Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 333**, FIREWORKS MODIFICATIONS, by Representative J. A. Dunnigan, with the following amendments and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1. Page 2, Lines 34 through 36:
 - 34 (1) (a) A municipality or county may require a retail seller to obtain a license and pay a
 - 35 reasonable fee before selling { class C } <u>a division 1.4G</u> common state-approved { explosives } <u>explosive, as defined in Section 53-7-202,</u> within the jurisdiction
 - 36 of that municipality or county.
- 2. Page 2, Lines 51 through 52:
 - 51 Board shall adopt standards by rule for the retail sales of consumer fireworks, and in doing so,
 - 52 shall consider the applicable provisions of <u>the</u> {<u>most recent</u>} <u>2013</u> edition of NFPA 1124, Chapter 7,
- 3. Page 7, Line 186:
 - 186 [(19)] (20) "Retail seller" means a person who sells [class C] division {-1.1G
 -} <u>1.4G</u> common
- 4. Page 9, Lines 262 through 263:
 - 262 (5) engages in the sale, storage, or handling of [elass C fireworks] division 1.4G
