Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee recommends **H.B. 347**, SPECIAL EDUCATION MODIFICATIONS, by Representative R. P. Ward, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. H.B. 347**, EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 38 through 45:
  - 38 (ii) provide an environment to all educators, school staff, and students that does not
  - 39 pose a predictable threat of serious bodily injury to the educators, school staff, or students;
  - 40 (iii) provide an education to all students in which the students' classroom is not
  - 41 {<u>predictably</u>} <u>significantly</u> disrupted in an ongoing fashion;
  - 42 (iv) provide an environment to all educators, school staff, and students that is free from
  - 43 <u>repeated:</u>
  - 44 (A) verbal or physical sexual harassment; or
  - 45 (B) sexual assault;
- 2. Page 5, Lines 125 through 127:
  - 125 (6) An LEA shall provide education to all students within the LEA in the least
  - 126
     restrictive environment possible that does not { predictably } significantly

     disrupt the education of other
  - 127 <u>students within the classroom in an ongoing fashion.</u>
