Mr. Speaker,

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 369**, DEFENSIVE FORCE AMENDMENTS, by Representative R. D. Wilcox, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 29 through 35:
 - 29 (1) [A person] Except as provided in Subsection (2), an actor is justified in using force
 - against [another] an individual when and to the extent that [he] the actor reasonably believes
 - that the force is necessary to prevent or terminate the [other's] individual's unlawful entry into _the actor's vehicle or unlawful entry_
 - or attack upon [his] the actor's habitation { , vehicle, } or place of business or employment.
 - 33 (2) [; however, he] An actor is justified in [the use of] using force against the individual
 - 34 <u>described in Subsection (1)</u> [which] that is intended or likely to cause death or serious bodily
 - injury to the individual only if:
