Mr. President,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 405**, PUBLIC HEALTH AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. Birkeland, with the following amendments:

1. Page 9, Line 270 through Page 10, Line 277d:

- 270        (2) "Dangerous public health condition" means any of the following:  
271        (a) cholera;  
272        (b) pneumonic plague;  
273        (c) severe acute respiratory syndrome;  
274        (d) smallpox;  
275        (e) tuberculosis;  
276        (f) any viral hemorrhagic fever; {~~and~~} or  
277        (g) ~~H~~→ [yellow fever] any infection;  
277a       (i) that is new, drug resistant, or reemerging;  
277b       (ii) that evidence suggests is likely to cause either high mortality or morbidity; and  
277c       (iii) only if the {~~chief executive officer of the relevant county~~} relevant  
legislative body of the county where the infection is located approves as needing  
277d       containment; ←~~H~~.
