Mr. Speaker,

The Transportation Committee recommends **H.B. 430**, LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AMENDMENTS, by Representative C. B. Pierucci, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 430**, LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 9, Lines 252 through 254:
 - (C) has a total change order value of \$200,000 or more[.]; and
 - 253 (v) coordinate with {<u>local advisory councils and</u>} political subdivisions within the large
 - 254 public transit district to provide and execute public transit innovation grants.
- 2. Page 15, Line 455 through Page 16, Line 466:
 - 455 generated from the local option sales and use tax for public transit innovation grants.
 - 456 (4) (a) <u>A large public transit district shall provide</u> {<u>an annual</u>} <u>a</u> report to each city and town
 - 457 <u>within the boundary of the large public transit district, which report shall provide an</u> <u>accounting</u>
 - 458 <u>of:</u>
 - 459 { (i) the amount of revenue from local option sales and use taxes under this part that was
 - 460 <u>collected within each respective county, city, or town and allocated to the large public</u> <u>transit</u>
 - 461 <u>district as provided in this part;</u>
 - 462 { (b) } (ii) how much revenue described in Subsection (4)(a) (i) was allocated to provide public
 - 463 <u>transit services within each city and town; and</u>







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- 464 (iii) how the revenue described in Subsection (4) { (b) } $\left\{ \frac{\mathbf{c}}{\mathbf{c}} \right\}$ (a)(ii) was spent to provide public transit 465 services within each respective city and town. (b) A large public transit district shall provide the report described in Subsection (4)(a): (i) on or before November 1, 2024; and (ii) at least every two years thereafter. (c) To provide the report described in this Subsection (4), a large public transit district may coordinate with the Department of Transportation to report on relevant public transit capital development administered by the Department of Transportation. 466 Section 6. Section 59-12-2219 is amended to read:
- 3. Page 22, Lines 648 through 650:
 - 648 (b) As provided in Section 59-12-2212.2, for the .10% designated for public transit
 - 649 <u>described in Subsection (3)(a) that is not contractually obligated for debt service,</u> <u>beginning on July 1, 2025,</u> <u>a large public</u>
 - 650 transit district shall expend 10% of the .10% for public transit innovation grants.
