The Judiciary Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 455**, EDUCATION INDUSTRY EMPLOYEE PRIVACY, by Representative T. Lee, with the following amendments:

- Page 3, Lines 60 through 64: 60 { (5) If an LEA requires an employee to utilize required technology that the employee **61** reasonably finds to contain objectionable terms and conditions, the LEA shall provide **62** reasonable accommodations to the impacted employee to avoid mandatory usage on the 63 employee's personal device. **64** <del>(6)</del>} (5) An LEA shall provide a reasonable accommodation { under Subsection (5) that Page 3, Line 72: 72 {<del>\_(7)</del>\_} (6) An LEA may not take adverse action against an employee for exercising rights Page 3, Line 74: 3. 74 (7) An employee may file a written complaint with the state board alleging violations
