The Judiciary Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 464**, SOCIAL MEDIA REGULATION ACT AMENDMENTS, by Representative J. D. Teuscher, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 4, Lines 110 through 115:
  - (ii) permits an individual to register as an account holder, establish an account, or
  - create a profile that is made visible to the general public or a set of other users defined by the
  - account holder for the <u>primary</u> purpose of allowing account holders to create, share, and view
  - 113 <u>user-generated content through such an account or profile;</u>
  - 114 (iii) primarily allows account holders to post content and interact with content generated by other
  - 115 <u>account holders; and</u>
- 2. Page 7, Line 211 through Page 8, Line 214:
  - 211 account  $\cdot$   $\{ =$  and
  - 212 <u>(e) displays content on a Utah minor account holder's account in the order it</u>

    <u>was</u>
  - 213 <u>posted, showing newer posts after older posts in a first posted, first shown manner, rather than</u>
    - 214 using algorithms or user interactions to determine order.
