Mr. Speaker,

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 477**, CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS OF SCHOOL EMPLOYEES, by Representative K. Birkeland, with the following amendments:

1. Page 3, Lines 64 through 67:

(b) The local school board shall provide the employee the opportunity to return to
regular work if :

(i) the investigation described in Subsection (5)(a):

(ii) the investigation described in Subsection (5)(a):
(c) {(i) } (A) concludes without leading to criminal charges; or
(c) {(ii) } (B) does not result in the conviction of the employee {...} ;

and
(ii) the local school board determines that no further employment action is warranted.
