Mr. Speaker,

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 478**, ANIMAL CARE AMENDMENTS, by Representative N. K Thurston, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 36 through 44:
  - 36 (4) If the department determines that a person has violated Subsection 76-9-301(2)(a)
  - or Section 76-9-301.9, the department may:
  - 38 (a) impose a civil fine of up to {\frac{\$1,000}{}}\ \text{\$\frac{\$500}{}}\ \text{per violation;}
  - 39 (b) seek a temporary restraining order;
  - 40 (c) seek an injunction;
  - 41 (d) seek an order of seizure or condemnation for an animal that is the subject of the
  - 42 <u>violation, if the department has identified a suitable animal care facility that accepts custody of</u>
  - 43 the animal; or
  - 44 (e) report the circumstances to law enforcement or a prosecutor.
