Mr. President,

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 116**, EVICTION NOTICE REQUIREMENTS AMENDMENTS, by Senator J. Plumb, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 4, Lines 95 through 106:
 - 95 (d) If the tenant is not present when the order of restitution is enforced:
 - 96 (i) the sheriff { or } , constable , or landlord shall notify the local animal control authority to take custody
 - 97 of the companion animal;
 - (ii) the animal control authority shall respond to take custody of the companion animal within one business day after the day on which the sheriff, constable, or landlord provides the notice described in Subsection (4)(d)(i);
 - 98 { (ii) the landlord shall provide the animal control authority with the name and last
 - 99 known contact information of the tenant; and
 - 100 { <u>(iii)</u> } <u>(iv)</u> the { <u>landlord</u> } <u>animal control authority</u> shall post a notice at the premises in a visible place with the name and
 - 101 <u>contact information of the animal control authority or organization where the companion</u>
 - animal is taken; and
 - 103 {<u>(iv) if requested by the tenant, the landlord shall provide the name and contact</u>
 - 104 <u>information of the animal control authority or organization where the companion</u> <u>animal is</u>
