Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 206**, YOUNG ADULT SERVICE FELLOWSHIP, by Senator A. Millner, with the following amendments, and, due to fiscal impact, recommends it be referred to the Rules Committee for prioritization.

- 1. Page 8, Lines 213 through 220:
 - 213 (c) (i) {Before} Subject to Subsection (4)(c)(ii), before a qualified partner organization accepts service from a participant, the
 - 214 <u>commission or third-party administrator shall enter into an agreement with the qualified partner</u>
 - organization that outlines the mutual expectations of the program and qualified partner
 - organization, including the exact amount of matching funds the qualified partner organization
 - 217 shall provide to the commission to contribute to a participant's stipend.
 - (ii) A qualified partner organization shall agree to contribute no less than \$5 per hour to a participant's stipend.
 - 218 (d) The agreement described in Subsection (4)(c) may include a provision that the
 - 219 program is reducing the qualified partner organization's matching fund requirement due to the
 - receipt of private donations, as described in Subsection (5)(c)(ii)(B).
