Mr. President,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 267**, RESPITE CARE AMENDMENTS, by Senator T. D. Weiler, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 42 through 46:
 - 42 (2) The division may, as funding permits and either directly or through one or more
 - 43 third parties who are under contract with the division, provide overnight respite care services
 - 44 and, concurrent with the respite care services, services for the individual who is eligible to
 - 45 receive division services, such as recreational therapy, community-based programs, therapeutic
 - 46 recreation, educational programs, transportation, or vocational rehabilitation.
