Page 9, Lines 256 through 263: 256 {+} (4) In any action for damages for personal injury, death, or property damage in which 257 an owner or operator of an agritourism activity is named as a defendant, the court shall undergo 258 a comparative negligence analysis and consider whether: 259 (a) the injured person deliberately disregarded conspicuously posted signs, verbal 260 instructions, or other warnings regarding safety measures during the activity; or 261 (b) any equipment, animals, or appliance used by the injured person during the activity 262 were used in a manner or for a purpose other than that for which a reasonable person should 263 have known they were intended.  $\{+\}$
