

**5th Sub. H.B. 84**  
**SCHOOL SAFETY AMENDMENTS**

Senator **Don L. Ipson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 25, Lines 744 through 751:*

744 (f) (i) "School employee" means an employee of a school whose duties and  
745 responsibilities require the employee to be physically present at a school's campus while school  
746 is in session.

747 (ii) "School employee" does not include a principal, teacher, or individual whose  
748 primary responsibilities require the employee to be primarily present in a classroom to teach,  
749 care for, or interact with students unless **;**

**(A)** the principal, teacher, or individual is employed at a  
750 school with 100 or fewer students ~~{or}~~ **;**

**(B)** **the principal, teacher, or individual is employed at a school with** adjacent campuses as  
determined by the state security

751 chief ~~{-}~~ **;** **or**

**(C) as provided in Subsection 53G-8-701.5(3).**

2. *Page 27, Lines 815 through 817:*

815 (10) ~~{A school guardian acting in an official capacity under this section is immune from~~

816 ~~any liability, civil or criminal, that otherwise might result by reason of action taken in~~

817 ~~fulfillment of this section if the action was reasonably taken in good faith.}~~ **A school guardian who**  
**has active status in the gurdian program is not liable for any civil damages or penalties if the school**  
**guradian:**

**(i) when carrying or storing a firearm:**

**(A) is acting in good faith; and**

**(B) is not grossly negligent; or**

**(ii) threatens, draws, or otherwise uses a firearm reasonably believing the action to be necessary**  
**in compliance with Section 76-2-402.**
