	(iii) has permanently affixed cranks that were installed at the time of original manufacture;
111	$[(c)] \{ (iii) \} (iv)$ is fully operable as a bicycle without the use of the electric motor; and
112	$\left[\frac{(d)}{(d)}\right] \left\{\frac{(d)}{(d)}\right\} $ is one of the following:
113	(A) a class 1 assisted bicycle;
