Representative **Jeffrey D. Stenquist** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 7 through 11:*

2. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 19:*

- 13 This bill makes changes related to outdoor recreation infrastructure.  
14 Highlighted Provisions:  
15 This bill:  
16 ▶ clarifies the definition for outdoor recreation infrastructure;  
▶ corrects the accounts for annual appropriations out of the Outdoor Adventure Infrastructure Restricted Account;  
17 ▶ allows the division to reimburse itself for costs from the Outdoor Adventure  
18 Infrastructure Restricted Account; and  
19 ▶ makes technical changes.

3. *Page 3, Lines 75 through 89:*

- 75 [~~(5)~~] (4) For each fiscal year, beginning with fiscal year 2023-2024, the Division of  
76 Finance shall, subject to appropriation by the Legislature, distribute money from the Outdoor  
77 Adventure Infrastructure Restricted Account as follows:  
78 (a) at least 15% to the Department of Natural Resources - Division of State Parks -  
79 Capital, to be expended using the department's existing prioritization process for capital  
80 projects in state parks described in Subsection [~~(4)~~] (3);  
81 (b) at least 22% to the Department of Natural Resources - Division of Outdoor  
82 Recreation - {~~Capital~~} Outdoor Recreation Infrastructure Account, to be expended for  
competitive Recreation Restoration Infrastructure  
83 grants or Outdoor Recreational Infrastructure grants for outdoor recreation capital projects and  
84 related maintenance expenses, where maintenance expenses do not exceed 15% of the  
85 appropriation; and  
86 (c) at least 53% to the Department of Natural Resources - Division of Outdoor

- 87 Recreation - {~~Capital~~} **Outdoor Adventure Infrastructure Restricted Account** , to be expended for  
larger outdoor recreation infrastructure projects
- 88 described in Subsection 3 as recommended to the Legislature by the Outdoor Adventure  
Commission [~~described in Subsection (4)~~].
