Senator **Daniel McCay** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 13:
 - 12 makes optional the requirement to obtain a certificate from the Department of
 - 13 Health and Human Services to provide residential child care;

▶ limits the number of children under three years old for which a residential child care provider operating without a license may provide care;

- 2. Page 6, Lines 168 through 174:
 - 168 (b) [Notwithstanding Subsection (1)(a), a person who] (i) A person that does not hold a
 - 169 license or certificate from the department under this part may not, at any given time, provide
 - 170 child care in the person's home for more than 10 children in total under the age of 13, or under
 - 171 the age of 18 if a child has a disability, regardless of whether a child is related to the person
 - 172 providing child care.

(ii) A person providing care described in Subsection (1)(a)(viii) may not provide, at any given time, child care in the person's home for more than three children who are under three years old.

- 173 (c) A person providing care described in Subsection (1)(a)(viii) that is not a certified provider or a
- 174 licensed provider under this part is subject to the requirements of Section 26B-2-406.
