- 16 psychologist; and
- 17 **•** prohibits the Division of Real Estate from requiring an applicant for an appraiser

  - 411 (d) submit to the board certified evidence of having completed at least one <u>academic</u> year of
  - 412 professional experience {+}, at least 30 hours per week {+} [for an academic year,] \_\_\_\_\_ of direct clinical
  - 413 experience in treatment and management of patients, supervised and attested to by one holding
