 - reasonable fee before selling { class C } a division 1.4G common state-approved { explosives } explosive, as defined in Section 53-7-202, within the jurisdiction
 - of that municipality or county.
- 2. *Page 2, Lines 51 through 52:*
 - 51 Board shall adopt standards by rule for the retail sales of consumer fireworks, and in doing so,
 - shall consider the applicable provisions of the { most recent } 2013 edition of NFPA 1124, Chapter 7,
- 3. Page 7, Line 186:
 - [(19)] (20) "Retail seller" means a person who sells [class C] division {1.1G} common
- 4. Page 9, Lines 262 through 263:
 - 262 (5) engages in the sale, storage, or handling of [class C fireworks] division 1.4G
 - 263 { explosive } common state approved explosives without a permit where a local government requires a permit;
