 - 163 (5) If the intended public purpose is for a mining use, a **private** person may not exercise the 164 power of eminent domain over property, or an interest in property, that is already used for a
 - 165 mining use within the boundary of:
 - 166 (a) a permit area, as defined in Section 40-8-4;
 - 167 (b) an area for which a permit has been issued by the Division of Water Quality, as part
 - 168 of the underground injection control program, under rules made by the Water Quality Board in
 - 169 accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act;
 - 170 (c) private property; or
 - 171 (d) an area under a state or federal lease.
