## Senator **Kirk A. Cullimore** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 54, Lines 1657 through 1667:
  - 1657 Transportation may use the money in this fund for any of the purposes detailed in Subsection
  - 1658 (4).
  - 1659 {+} (9) {-Any-} Subject to Subsection (10), any revenue deposited into the fund as described in Subsection (2)(e) shall be
  - used to provide funding or loans for public transit projects, operations, and supporting
  - infrastructure in the county of the first class. {+}
  - 1662 { (10) For the first three years after a county of the first class imposes a sales and use tax
  - authorized in Section 59-12-2220, revenue deposited into the fund as described in Subsection
  - 1664 (2)(e) shall be allocated as follows:
  - (a) 10% to the department to construct an express bus facility on 5600 West; and
  - 1666 (b) 90% into the County of the First Class Infrastructure Bank Fund created in Section
  - 1667 72-2-302.
- 2. Page 57, Lines 1743 through 1750:
  - (c) (i) Construction related to the project described in Subsection (4)(a)(ix)(D) may not
  - 1744 commence until a right-of-way not owned by a federal agency that is required for the
  - realignment and extension of U-111, as described in the department's 2023 environmental
  - 1746 <u>study related to the project, is</u> { <u>donated</u>} <u>dedicated</u> <u>to the department.</u>
  - 1747 (ii) Notwithstanding Subsection (4)(c)(i), if a right-of-way is not {donated} for the
  - 1748 project as described in Subsection (4)(c)(i) on or before { July } October 1, 2024, the department may
  - proceed with the project, except that the project will be limited to two lanes on U-111 from
  - 1750 Herriman Parkway to 11800 South.
