1. Page 10, Line 304 through Page 11, Line 308:

- 304 (b) (i) If a governmental entity or a contractor described in Subsection (4)(a) is subject
- 305 <u>to a more restrictive or</u> <u>a more</u> specific provision of law than found in this part, the governmental
- 306 <u>entity</u> <u>or contractor</u> <u>shall comply with the more restrictive or</u> <u>more</u> <u>specific provision of law.</u>
- 307 (ii) For purposes of Subsection (1)(b)(i), Title 63G, Chapter 2, Government Records
- 308 <u>Access and Management Act, is a more</u> {<u>restrictive and</u>} <u>specific provision of law</u> <u>and shall control</u> <u>over the provisions of this part</u>.
