 - 90 (4) It is not a defense under this section that {
 - 91 <u>(a) the actor committing the offense did not intend for the business or governmental</u>
 - 92 <u>entity to incur the cost of the economic interruption; or</u>
 - 93 (b) the actor did not know that the victim is a business or governmental entity.
