Senator Nate Blouin proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 23 through 25:
 - clarifies the effects of a concurrent resolution upon adoption;
 - establishes requirements for the termination of a concurrent resolution; {-and-}
 - clarifies the effects of legislative inaction on a federal directive {-} ; and
 - <u>▶ prohibits the Legislature from requesting a concurrent resolution if the adoption would</u> result in a loss of federal funds.
- 2. Page 5, Lines 124 through 125:
 - action to challenge the federal directive on the basis of state sovereignty.
 - (9) Notwithstanding Subsection (1), the Legislature may not request a concurrent resolution under this section if the adoption of the concurrent resolution would result in the loss of federal funds, as defined in Section 63J-5-102.
 - 125 (9) This section supersedes any conflicting provisions of Utah law.
