1. Page 4, Lines 101 through 107:

{ (6) (a) If a person providing a notification under Subsection (1)(c) to the Office of the
Attorney General or the Utah Cyber Center submits the information required under Subsection
63G-2-309(1)(a)(i), records submitted to the Office of the Attorney General or the Utah Cyber
Center under Subsection (1)(c), including the information required under Subsection (6)(b),
and information produced by the Office of the Attorney General or the Utah Cyber Center for
any coordination or assistance provided to the person are presumed to be confidential and are a
protected record under Subsections 63G-2-305(1) and (2).}

(6)(a) The following information may be deemed confidential and classified as a protected record under Subsections 63G-2-305(1) and (2), if the confidentiality requirements of Subsection 63G-2-309(1)(a)(i) are met:

(i) a notification submitted under Subsection (1)(c), including supporting information provided under Subsection (6)(b); and

(ii) information produced by the Office of the Attorney General or the Utah Cyber Center in providing coordination or assistance to person providing notification under Subsection (1)(c).
