 - 64 (1) (a) An adult individual, other than the parent or legal guardian of the minor in possession
 - of a device, who disables the filter required under Section 78B-6-2602 on a device in
 - 66 possession of a minor for the purpose of disseminating pornography to the minor, commits a class A misdemeanor.
 - 67 (b) For each offense, the violator is subject to fines up to \$5,000.
 - 68 (2) Any person who has a prior conviction under this section, is guilty of a felony of
 - 69 the third degree and shall, for each separate offense, be fined { up to } an amount not to exceed \$50,000 and may be
 - 70 <u>imprisoned for</u> { <u>up to one year</u>} <u>zero to five years</u> .
- 2. Page 5, Line 119:
 - accordance with this section.
 - (3) Nothing in this part creates a cause of action against the retailer of a device.
