

**1st Sub. S.B. 104**  
**CHILDREN'S DEVICE PROTECTION ACT**

Senator **Todd D. Weiler** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Lines 64 through 70:*

- 64           (1) (a) An adult individual, other than the parent or legal guardian of the minor in possession  
65   of a device, who disables the filter required under Section 78B-6-2602 on a device in  
66   possession of a minor for the purpose of disseminating pornography to the minor, commits a class A  
      misdemeanor.
- 67           (b) For each offense, the violator is subject to fines up to \$5,000.
- 68           (2) Any person who has a prior conviction under this section, is guilty of a felony of  
69   the third degree and shall, for each separate offense, be fined ~~{up to}~~ an amount not to exceed  
      \$50,000 and may be  
70   imprisoned for ~~{up to one year}~~ zero to five years .
