Senator Todd D. Weiler proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 82 through 85:
  - 82 (3) "Filter" means generally accepted and commercially reasonable software used on a device that is {reasonably} capable of preventing
  - 83 the device from accessing or displaying obscene material through Internet browsers or search
  - 84 <u>engines</u> <u>owned or controlled by the manufacturer</u> in accordance with prevailing industry standards via mobile data networks, wired
  - 85 Internet networks, and wireless Internet networks.

2. Page 4, Lines 88 through 90:

(a) (i) is engaged in the business of manufacturing a device;
(ii) holds the patents for the device the person manufactures; {and} or
(iii) holds the patents for the operating system on a device; and
(iii) holds the patents for the operating system on a device; and
(c) (b) has a commercial registered agent as that term is defined in Section 16-17-102.

## 3. Page 4, Lines 93 through 107:

93 (7) "Obscenity" means the same as that term is defined in Section 32B-1-504. (8) "Operating system" means software that manages all of the other application programs on a device. 94 (9) "Password" means a string of characters or other secure method used to enable, {<del>-(8)</del>-} deactivate, modify, or uninstall a filter on a device. 95 96 {<del>-(9)</del>-} (10) (a) "Retailer" means a person, that is not a manufacturer, that sells a device directly 97 to consumers. 98 (b) "Retailer" includes an employee of a retailer acting in the course and scope of the 99 employee's employment. 100 {<del>(10)</del>} (11) "Smart phone" means the same as that term is defined in Section 63A-2-101.5. 101 (12) "Tablet" means a mobile device that: {<del>(11)</del>} 102 (a) is equipped with a mobile operating system, touchscreen display, and rechargeable 103 battery; and 104 (b) has the ability to support access to a cellular network. 105 (13) "Video game console" means a discrete computing system, including the system's {<del>(12)</del>} 106 components and peripherals, primarily used for playing video games, but does not include a 107 smartphone or tablet.

- 4. Page 4, Lines 112 through 114:
  - 112 (2) {<u>determine the age of a user</u>} <u>ask the user to provide the user's age</u> <u>during activation</u> and account set-up;
  - 113 (3) automatically enable the filter when the user is a minor based on the {determination} age provided by the user as described
  - 114 <u>in Subsection (2);</u>
- 5. Page 5, Lines 128 through 131:
  - 128 makes a good faith effort to provide a device that, upon activation of the device in the state { and
  - 129 <u>using the age provided by the user, automatically enables a generally accepted and</u>
  - 130 <u>commercially reasonable filter that blocks obscene content on all Internet browsers or search</u>
  - 131engines accessed on the device in accordance with this section }. automatically enables a filter inaccordance with Section 78B-6-2602.
