## Senator Curtis S. Bramble proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 26 through 36:
  - 26 (1) As used in this section, "public cold bath" means a tub or tank that:
  - (a) is used by:
  - 28 (i) the general public, regardless of whether there is a charge or payment for use; and
  - 29 (ii) one bather at a time; {-and-}
  - 30 (b) contains chilled water that is:
  - 31 (i) maintained at a temperature lower than 60 degrees Fahrenheit;
  - 32 (ii) no more than 180 gallons in volume; and
  - 33 (iii) at a depth that allows the bather to maintain the bather's head above the water
  - 34 while in a seated position {-} ; and
    - (c) continuously filters and santizes the chilled water.
  - 35 (2) The department may not adopt a rule that restricts, limits, or imposes requirements
  - on the operation of a public cold bath.
