 - an online digital audio or visual communication described in Subsection (2) that is viewable,
 - audible, or accessible in the state shall ensure the advertisement carries embedded tamper-evident digital
 - 69 content provenance that discloses:
- 3. Page 4, Lines 88 through 91:
 - 88 (2) The sentencing judge or the Board of Pardons and Parole { shall } may consider as an
 - 89 aggravating factor in their deliberations that the defendant committed or facilitated the criminal
 - 90 offense with the intentional or knowing use and material assistance of an artificial intelligence
 - 91 system.
