Senator **Nate Blouin** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Line 18:

- ▶ authorize the legal voters to propose a constitutional amendment; and

(3) Notwithstanding Article XXIII, the legal voters of the State of Utah, in the numbers required for the legal voters to initiate legislation, may propose an amendment to this constitution and cause it to be submitted to:

(a) the voters for passage by a 60% vote of those voting on it; and

(b) if the voters pass the constitutional amendment, to the Legislature for approval by a majority vote of the members elected in each house.
