Mr. Speaker,

The Judiciary Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 203**, JUDICIAL STANDING AMENDMENTS, by Senator B. Brammer, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page Line 58 through 60:
 - 58 the constitutional rights of a third party, the plaintiff shall establish that:
 - 59 (a)the {plaintiff} third party meets the traditional standing requirement for bringing the action;
 - 60 (b)the plaintiff has a substantial relationship with the third party;
- 2. Page Line 64 through 72:
 - 64 <u>bringing the action.</u>
 - 65 (4)If the plaintiff is an association bringing a private right of action on behalf of {<u>the</u>}
 - 66 {<u>association's members</u>} <u>any member of the association</u>, the plaintiff shall plead with particularity that:
 - 67 (a)the {<u>members of the association meet</u>} <u>member meets</u> the traditional standing requirement for bringing

- 68 {<u>the action</u>} <u>a private right of action</u>;
- 69 (b)the {members consent} member consents to the association bringing the action on the behalf of the

- 71 (c)the participation of the {members} member is not necessary to the resolution of the action.
- 72 (5)Notwithstanding Subsection (1) or (2), a plaintiff may bring a private right of action in a
