Dear President Adams and Speaker Schultz,

This letter serves to inform you that on March 27, 2025, I signed Senate Bill 3, *Appropriations Adjustments*, from the 2025 General Session with the following line item vetoes:

- Item 177, lines 1418-1424; Item 201, lines 1738-1744; and Item 209, lines 1793-1799. Senate Bill 106, *Utah-Ireland Trade Commission* was vetoed.
- Item 249, lines 2207-2213. This item of appropriation, House Bill 277, *Vehicle Registration Amendments*, did not pass.
- Item 261, lines 2308-2316. This item of appropriation, Senate Bill 222, *Vehicle Emission Inspection Program Revisions*, did not pass.
- Item 454, lines 4098-4104. Senate Bill 37, *Minimum Basic Tax Rate Amendments*, which would have authorized the deposit of local property tax revenues into the state's General Fund was vetoed. As a result, the funding that this item transfers from the General Fund into the Income Tax Fund is no longer available.
